## What vaccines do YOU need?

Tetanus/Diptheria	Everyone, every 10 years
Pertussis	Everyone, once in adulthood
(Whooping Cough)	·
Measles/Mumps/Rubella	People who have not had 2 doses of the vaccine
	after their 1st birthday and no documented proof of
	disease
Influenza	Everyone, annually
Hepatitis A	Anyone at risk of exposure through their occupation or travel. Police Officers are at an increased risk due to possible exposure to unsanitary residential conditions
Hepatitis B	Anyone at risk of exposure through their occupation, lifestyle or environment. All Emergency Service Workers are at an increased risk of contracting Hepatitis B and should have the series of 3 injections plus post-vaccination bloodwork to confirm immunity.
Pneumoncoccal	Anyone age 65 or older or those at high risk due to
(Pneumonia)	medical conditions
Varicella	Anyone who has not had the disease
(Chicken Pox)	
Herpes Zoster (Shingles)	Anyone age 60 or older
